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Privately owned passenger vehicles used to transport youth must be:

- Properly registered
- Insured
- Driven by individuals with a valid license for the type of vehicle used.

Vehicles must be used for their intended purpose and a seat belt must be provided for each passenger. Drivers are not authorized to transport more than six persons, to include the driver and any chaperone(s).

Insured vehicles must meet industry-suggested requirements of minimal coverage as indicated below:

\$300,000	Combined Single Limit
	- or -
\$100,000	Per Person – Bodily Injury
\$300,000	Per Accident
\$50,000	Property Damage

In the event of an accident, the driver’s insurance will be deemed as the primary insurance.
